- 2. This emergency grant aid is to provide food and nutrition support to Mozambique, Malawi, Lesotho and Swaziland, in light of serious humanitarian needs such as food shortage and malnutrition caused by El-Niño phenomenon.
- 3. In this regard, the Kingdom of Swaziland will received Maize, Pulses and Vegetable Oil for 200 thousand US dollars.
