In PRSAP, the primary development priorities are to improve the quality of life for the poor and increase the income and correct inequality. Urgent challenge of education sector is to improve the quality of and accesses to secondary education because of an increase in the number of people going to secondary education due to implementing free education in the public primary education from 2010.	[Strategy] In education sector, Japan supports improvement in the quality of and the accesses to secondary education focusing on science and math courses contributing to development of country. In other sectors, Japan supports reducing disparities of social services through approaching the basic health sector, agricultural sector and climate change sector which exert baleful influences on the livelihood of social vulnerable group.
