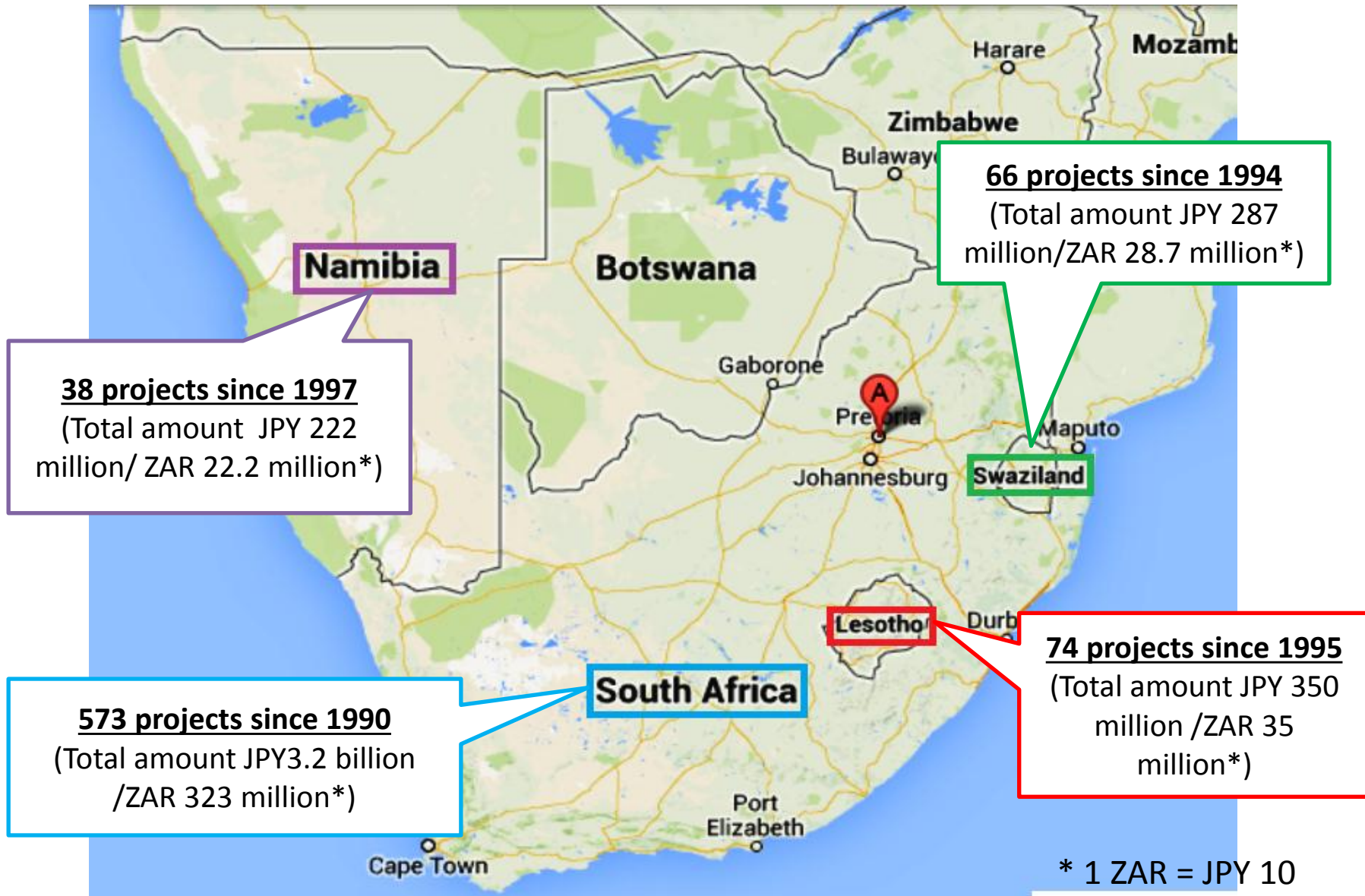

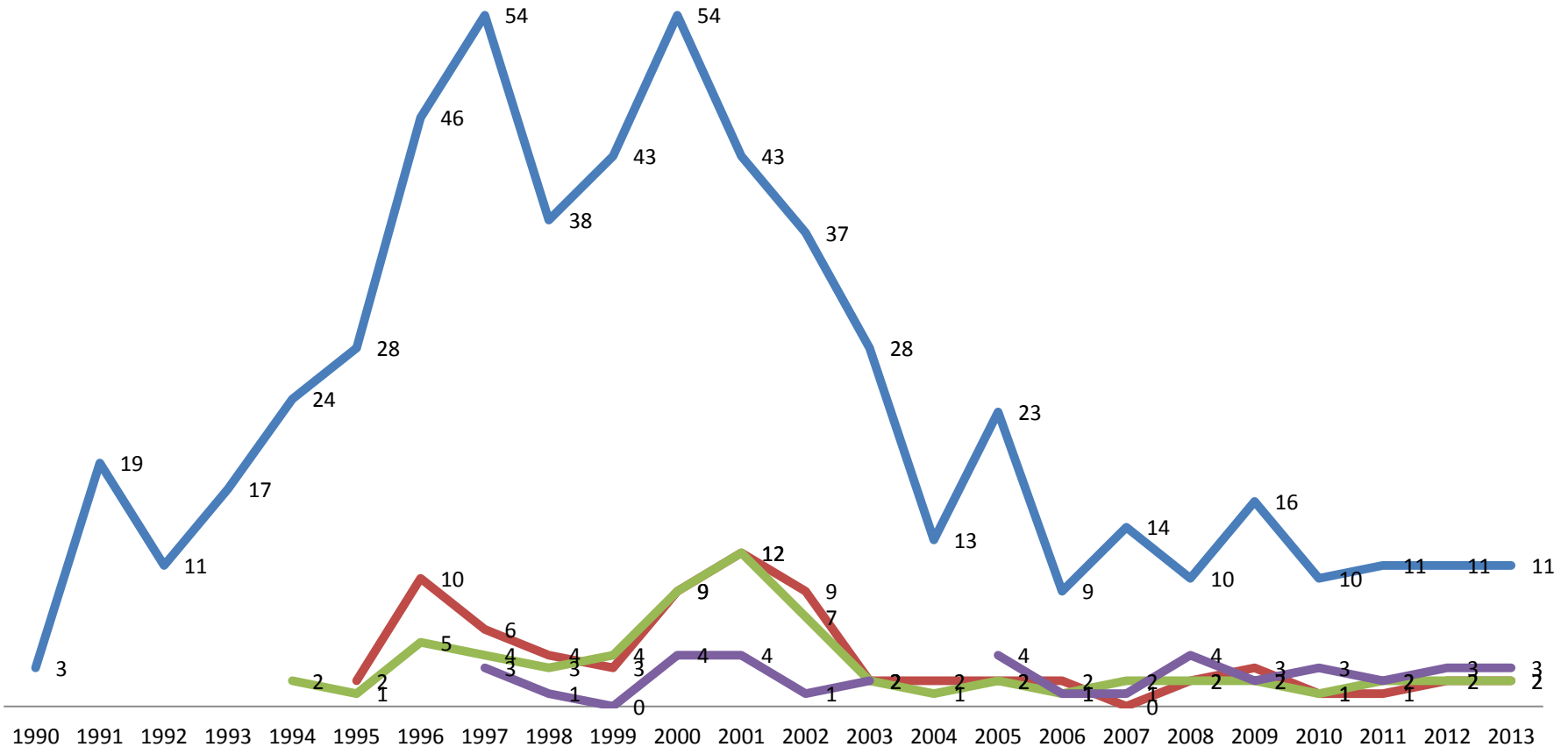


# GGP Projects by Countries from 1990 to 2013
