

Komatsu launches new R950 million industry complex in Gauteng

On the 22nd of November, 2018, a brand-new R950 million Komatsu industrial complex in Gauteng has officially opened with the attendance of Chargé d'Affaires ad interim, Mr. Shuichiro Kawaguchi from the Embassy of Japan, Komatsu Ltd President and CEO, Mr. Tetsuji Ohashi, and Trade and Industry Minister, Mr. Rob Davies.

South Africa has become an integral and strategic part of Komatsu's global business, with the Japan's general machine production firm employing as many as 2,500 local workers in Southern Africa, including 1,000 in South Africa. The new industrial complex incorporates the head branch office of Komatsu South Africa (Pty) Ltd, its distribution centre, equipment workshop as well as technical training centre.
