
Exchange of Notes
between
the Government of Japan
and
the World Food Programme (WFP)
for
the Food Assistance Programme



- 1. On 18<sup>th</sup> of February 2019, Mr. Shuichiro Kawaguchi, Minister Counsellor of the Embassy of Japan, and Ms. Mary Njoroge, Representative and Country Director of WFP Lesotho, concluded the Exchange of Notes for the Food Assistance Programme in the presence of Hon. Mr. Lesego Makgothi, Minister of Foreign Affairs and International Relations of the Kingdom of Lesotho.
- 2. The Government of Japan committed to make a grant aid of up to one hundred and fifty million Japanese Yen (¥150,000,000) available for the procurement of about 204 tons of tinned fish from Japan.
- 3. The tinned fish will be distributed mainly to primary schools all over Lesotho, and is expected to improve the nutritional condition of the school children who have been suffering the effects of a severe drought over the years.
