



- On 30th of September 2019, Mr. Shuichiro Kawaguchi, Minister Counsellor of the Embassy of Japan, and Ms. Mary Njoroge, Representative and Country Director of WFP Lesotho, concluded the Exchange of Notes on Food Aid, witnessed by Mr. Thabang Lekhela, Deputy Principal Secretary, Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Relations and Mr. Teboho Moneri, Regional Inspector Central, Ministry of Education and Training of the Kingdom of Lesotho.
- 2. The Government of Japan committed to make a grant aid of up to two hundred million Japanese Yen (¥200,000,000) available for the procurement of about 310 tons of tinned fish from Japan.
- 3. Lesotho has been suffering from severe drought over the years. This food aid will help about 180,000 primary school children all over the Lesotho to improve their nutritional condition.
