 - Scott Hospital Morija, Maseru
 - Mamohau Hospital, Leribe
 - Maluti Adventist Hospital, Berea

- The donation was the result of a partnership between; The embassy, the Society for Promotion of Japanese Diplomacy (SPJD) and the Yokohama city Rotary Club. Yokohama city Rotary club donated the recycled Ambulances to SPJD who in turn facilitated the transfer of ownership to CHAL. The embassy sponsored the transportation of the vehicles from Japan to Lesotho, as well the training provided. SPJD provided training for optimal use of the ambulance equipment
