

# Pink Drive: Mobile Mammography Unit (R2,912,711)

- In 2015 the Embassy of Japan, in a Public Private Partnership (PPP) with FUJIFILM SOUTH AFRICA, provided a fully equipped mammography unit to Pink Drive.
- This mobile unit allows for Pink Drive to carry out advanced screening for breast and other cancers, in areas where such equipment is rare.
- The advanced diagnostic equipment was sourced from FUJIFILM, and the company donated the truck's characteristic pink signage.



# Pink Drive: Mobile Screening Vans (R815,611)

- Following the success and reach of the first PPP with Pink Drive, the Embassy of Japan donated two converted minivans in 2017.
- The two minivans, affectionately called Shobu (Japanese Iris) and Sakura (Cherry Blossom), are used to carry out testing in Kwa-Zulu Natal.
