

### Announcement of the Start of the Application Process for the Japanese Language Proficiency Test

We are pleased to announce that we will once again be conducting the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) in South Africa. This year's test will be held **on the morning of the 3rd of December 2023** at the Japanese School of Johannesburg. Applications will be accepted as follows:

1. Application Period: **From 10 July to 31 August, 2023**  
**※Please allow plenty of time to submit the application. Applications which arrive at the Embassy later than 31 August won't be accepted**
2. How to apply:
  - ①Download **the application form**.
  - ②Fill in the form, referring to **the test guide**. ※When you fill it digitally, you need to fill only the first page. The other pages will be automatically filled.
  - ③Print out **all 5 pages single sided on A4 sheets**.
  - ④Attach ID photos (4cm×3cm, colour or black / white) on page 4 and 5.
  - ⑤Sign manually on pages 1, 2 and 3.
  - ⑥Courier or hand deliver your completed application form to:

3. Levels: N1-N5 (only one level may be taken per applicant).
4. Cost: **R400** per applicant.

For the convenience of sorting, please include "JLPT2023" and your name in the subject line. Bank transfer fees are the responsibility of the applicant.
