We are pleased to announce that we will once again be conducting the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) in South Africa. This year's test will be held <u>on the morning of the 3rd of December 2023</u> at the Japanese School of Johannesburg. Applications will be accepted as follows:

1. Application Period: <u>From 10 July to 31 August, 2023</u>

Embassy later than 31 August won't be accepted

- 2. How to apply:
  - ①Download the application form.
  - ②Fill in the form, referring to **the test guide**. ※When you fill it digitally, you need to fill only the first page. The other pages will be automatically filled.
  - ③Print out all 5 pages single sided on A4 sheets.
  - (4) Attach ID photos (4cm×3cm, colour or black / white) on page 4 and 5.
  - ⑤Sign manually on pages 1, 2 and 3.

- 3. Levels: N1-N5 (only one level may be taken per applicant).
- 4. Cost: **R400** per applicant.

Payment: Please make payment prior to application to the following bank account and submit proof of EFT Payment / Bank Transfer / Deposit Slip via email (the data size should be under 5MB) to info@pr.mofa.go.jp. For the convenience of sorting, please include "JLPT2023" and your name in the subject line. Bank transfer fees are the responsibility of the applicant.
