

## Announcement of the Start of the Application Process for the Japanese Language Proficiency Test

We are pleased to announce that we will once again be conducting the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) in South Africa. This year's test will be held <u>on the morning of the 1st of December 2024</u> at the Japanese School of Johannesburg. Applications will be accepted as follows:

- 1. Application Period: From 8 July to 30 August/2024

  \*\*Please allow plenty of time to submit the application. Applications which arrive at the Embassy later than 30 August will not be accepted.
- 2. How to apply:
  - ①Download the application form.
  - ②Fill out the necessary information while referring to the test guide. (If filling out electronically, only fill in the first page. The information will automatically be reflected on pages 2 and beyond).
  - ③Attach a photo (4cm x 3cm, colour or black and white) to the designated spots on pages 4 and 5.
  - 4 Sign by hand in the designated spots on pages 1 to 3.
  - ⑤Submit the completed application form via courier, direct submission, or email (PDF format) to the address below:
