The Government of Japan provides grant assistance to Sacred Heart High School

LERIBE, 20 January 2026 – The Embassy of Japan in the Kingdom of Lesotho signed a grant contract with Sacred Heart High School in Maputsoe, Leribe, under the Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP) Programme. This grant aims to address the challenge of overcrowding in classrooms.
