Development Assignments: Economy infrastructure development	The current situation and problem: On the basis of the Vision 2030, long term national development plan of Namibia, and the 4th National Development Plan(NPD4, 2012-2016), the Republic of Namibia adopted economic and infrastructure development as priority areas and is promoting those developments. Namibia has economic corridors such as Caprivi corridor, Kalahali corridor, which are gateways for inland countries. In order to take in foreign investment without being left behind by Eastern African countries and SADC markets, Namibia must proceed to develop infrastructure strategically. At the same time, economic and industrial infrastructure development, promotion of small and medium-sized enterprises and entrepreneurs, construction of the system and human resource development are necessary for Namibia to break away from a monoculture economy and accelerate the economic growth.					A course of action: Expansion of the assistance centering technical cooperation for infrastructure and the involving system and human resource development by technical cooperation and Japanese ODA loans. Introduction of training and JOCV scheme for small and medium size businesses in order to raise human resources which are essential for the base of economic growing.
